Eliminate Sexual Assault

~ Sexual Assault is a crime. It is INTENTIONAL sexual contact through force, physical threat or abuse of authority or when the victim DOES NOT or CANNOT consent.

- ~ Take steps every day to foster a culture of dignity and respect.
