This Directive implements Title 10 United States Code Section 8020 *Inspector General*; Title 32 United States Code, Section 105, *Inspection*; Department of Defense Directive 5106.04, *Defense Inspectors General*; and is consistent with Headquarters Air Force Mission Directive 1-20, *The Inspector General*. It applies to all Air Force uniformed personnel (Regular, Air Force Reserve, and Air National Guard) and civilian personnel. Refer recommended changes and questions about this publication to the Office of Primary Responsibility using the AF Form 847, *Recommendation for Change of Publication*; route AF Forms 847 from the field through appropriate functional' s chain of command. Ensure that all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained in accordance with Air Force Manual 33-363, *Management of Records*, and disposed of in accordance with Air Force Records Information Management System, and Records Disposition Schedule.

SUMMARY OF CHANGES

Recent changes to this publication include removing acronyms and jargon from Air Force policy.

1. Policy. This Air Force Policy Directive creates the necessary overarching structure to enable and execute the Air Force Inspection System efficiently and effectively. The Air Force will evaluate the state of discipline, economy, efficiency, readiness, through the use of Air Force Inspection System.

2. Responsibilities .

2.1. The Secretary of the Air Force, Inspector General (SAF/IG) will:

2.1.1. Assess the readiness, discipline, efficiency, and economy of the Air Force and the Air Reserve Component, and report findings to the Secretary of the Air Force, the Air Force Chief of Staff, and MAJCOM/CCs, as applicable.

2.1.2. Serve as the Gatekeeper for all inspections, evaluations, assessments, and other inspection-related visits (including audits) conducted by outside entities (Office of the Inspector General, Department of Defense; Government Accountability Office; and others).

2.2. MAJCOM Commanders will:

2.2.1. Establish inspection programs consistent with mission requirements to assess Air Force and Air Reserve Component unit readiness, compliance with directives, and nuclear surety/safety (as applicable) within AF Instruction 90-201, *The Air Force Inspection System*, prescribed timelines and conduct other inspections required by law, as deemed necessary by the Commander.

2.2.2. Appoint a MAJCOM Gatekeeper responsible for ensuring the notification of evaluations by all Air Force and non-Air Force agencies.

Regular Air Force—the component of the Air Force that consists of persons whose continuous service on active duty in both peace and war is contemplated by law, and of retired members of the Regular Air Force.
