This directive states the mission, defines the command structure, and establishes the responsibilities of United States Space Forces – Northern (USSPACEFOR-NORTH). Refer to Space Force Instruction (SFI) 13-105 for general mission functions of Component Field Commands in support of staff operations, readiness, and structures. Refer recommended changes and questions about this publication to the office of primary responsibility using the DAF Form 847, *Recommendation for Change of Publication*; route DAF Forms 847 from field units through appropriate chain of command. Ensure all records generated as a result of processes prescribed in this publication adhere to Air Force Instruction 33-322, *Records Management and Information Governance Program*, and disposed of in accordance with the Air Force Records Disposition Schedule located in the Air Force Records Information Management System.

1. Mission. USSPACEFOR-NORTH is a Component Field Command of the United States Space Force (USSF) and is the Space Force Service Component assigned to the United States Northern Command (USNORTHCOM). USSPACEFOR-NORTH provides CDRUSNORTHCOM with capabilities-focused space forces to conduct the full range of military operations. USSPACEFOR-NORTH advances U.S. interests, promotes regional stability, and enhances security in the USNORTHCOM area of responsibility.

2. Command.

2.1. The Commander USSPACEFOR-NORTH (COMSPACEFOR-NORTH) reports and is responsible to the Chief of Space Operations for the execution of the Secretary of the Air Force's responsibilities to provide Service-specific administration and support functions for USSF forces assigned or attached to USNORTHCOM, to include specified administrative control of combat formations allocated by other Field Commands, as directed.

2.2. The COMSPACEFOR-NORTH exercises operational and tactical control of USSF forces as delegated by the CDRUSNORTHCOM.

2.3. The COMSPACEFOR-NORTH, if designated as the Theater/Joint Forces Space Component Commander, provides command and control to all space forces made available by CDRUSNORTHCOM, or Presidential directives.

3. Responsibilities . The COMSPACEFOR-NORTH shall:

3.1. Plan, integrate, synchronize, and execute space operations and the delivery of space effects as directed by CDRUSNORTHCOM, and provide support, as directed, to North American Aerospace Defense Command (NORAD) objectives.

3.2. Maintain situational awareness of all USSF personnel supporting USNORTHCOM missions.

3.3. Organize USSPACEFOR-NORTH forces subject to direction by CDRUSNORTHCOM.

3.4. Oversee and execute training and readiness for USSF forces assigned or attached to USNORTHCOM.

3.5. Execute any additional responsibilities specific to the USNORTHCOM mission or assigned by the CDRUSNORTHCOM.
